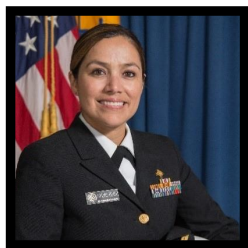
Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America (EHE) is a bold plan that aims to end the HIV epidemic in the United States by 2030. The plan leverages critical scientific advances in HIV prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and outbreak response by coordinating the highly successful programs, resources, and infrastructure of many HHS agencies and offices.

The Prevention through Active Community Engagement (PACE) Program under the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Health in collaboration with Gilead Sciences - HIV Prevention Medical Sciences is pleased to announce a three part webinar series designed to engage a wide range of health care workforce professionals, both from the private and public sector to discuss how they can take action in their organizations and communities on ending the HIV epidemic.

### The goals of the three-part webinar series are to:

1. Bring attention to national recommendations for specific vulnerable populations who are disproportionately impacted by HIV
